Matt Allen was interviewed for the piece and stated that most class actions end with a settlement. Even when the company feels the claim is baseless, settling is the cheaper route. “If there’s risk, and there is for the defendant, you can get an individual settlement for nuisance value at the front end of the case before you invest thousands, if not a million dollars into defending the case.
